SGC HOUSE RED - CABERNET / SHIRAZ

120 / 40

2022 - Produced by Kowie Du Toit. Vibrant red in colour. Herbs and spices on the nose with dark fruit and berries on the palate. Very well balanced with soft tannins.

MERLOT

2020 - Stellenbosch Hills' enchanting whiffs of violet and cherry blossom are the first impression. The wine is beautifully balanced and the velvety smooth palate rewards with luscious ripe plum and melting chocolate flavours on the lingering finish.

VILLIERA - MONRO MERLOT 520

2020 - Intensely aromatic with forthcoming berry fruit and hints of chocolate, spice and vanilla. It is well balanced with velvety texture but with enough grip to ensure good length. The complexity will ensure that Monro Merlot should keep for up to 10 years.

STELLENBOSCH RESERVE - 220 KWEEKSKOOL MERLOT

2020 - Aromas of bramble and damson plum combine with dark chocolate, cherry molasses and tobacco. The ripe aromas on the nose follow through onto the palate, with sweet, ripe fruit balanced by savoury notes of bay leaf and thyme. Fine, ripe tannins and fresh acidity support the plush midpalate, culminating in a clean, fruity finish.

GUARDIAN PEAK MERLOT 180 / 60

2023 - Bright tropical fruit, with typical notes of granadilla, cape gooseberry and lime cordial. Intense fruit on the palate is lifted by a crisp and refreshing acidity, with a touch of salinity that encourages another sip

VILLIERA MERLOT 220

2021 - The colour of the wine is brilliant red. The aroma shows hints of wood spice and mint with attractive red berry fruit. On the palate the wine is rich and full with juicy soft tannins ensuring drinkability. It will however mature for up to six years from vintage.

RAINBOW'S END MERLOT 390

2021 - Dark deep crimson colour. Aromas of blueberries, ripe. Full velvety mouth feel with hints of berry compote, mulberries and ripe plums. This is a well structured wine with rounded tannins balancing out opulent fruit and a long lingering finish.

MURATI - ALBERTA 375 ANNEMARIE

2019 - Redolent of lusciously ripe plums in its youth, this wine has complex layers of dark cherries, cocoa, cinnamon and toasted hazelnut (from 16 months in French oak barrels) that come to the fore over time. Its appealing sweetness and full-bodied richness are balanced by fresh acidity and a pinch of mixed herbs.

2015 - This classic Merlot was matured in French barrique for 12 months and only 2300 bottles of this sought after wine have been produced. This is a smooth, mild to medium bodied wine and can be enjoyed with seafood, pasta, mild cheeses and meat dishes.

BEYERSKLOOF - DIESEL PINOTAGE

2020 - A big structured wine with intense dark fruit flavours and pleasant hints of chocolate from the barrel toasting. This wine has great depth and balance with a lasting finish. The wine will age superbly for 10 years or longer and will pair well with matured Sirloin/Rib eye on the bone and spicy Indian curries.

The beautifully integrated plush, creamy tannins with satisfying acidity result in a wonderfully balanced wine with a long finish, promising great maturation potential.

RUST EN VREDE ESTATE 780

2018 - Named to reflect the planting on the property, the grapes for this wine come from 22 hectares of Cabernet Sauvignon, 7 hectares of Syrah and 1 hectare of Merlo. Rich cassis and mulberry with cedar and tobacco reveal Cabernet as the backbone to the blend, after which fresh red and black cherry with black pepper spice show the Syrah component. Intense fruit flavours are layered with mocha, Christmas cake, sandalwood and leather, bringing complexity to the wine. Fresh, fruity acidity balances the firm, coating tannins, culminating in a clean, dry finish that indicates good ageing potential.

ALTO ESTATE BLEND 700

2021 - Minerality and dark berries follow through onto the palate. A multi dimensional and engaging wine with a good combination of freshness and concentration on the mid palate. This wine perfectly complements smoked red meat and poultry and is excellent served with charcuterie and mature cheeses

ALTO ROUGE

220 / 75

2021 - The dark ruby Alto Rouge consists of an exquisite blend of five varietals – Cabernet Franc, Shiraz, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. It is the ideal pairing for flavoured red meat, game and duck dishes. Colour: Deep and rich red. Bouquet: Rich, dark fruit flavours supported by cedarwood spice and hints of chocolate dominate the nose. Taste: Fresh red and rich dark fruit flavours on the palate, backed up by soft, elegant tannins. Rich, balanced finish.

2020 - Baking blueberries, mulberries on the vine, leafy and sweet, cedar and spice. Generous and broad on the palate with fleshy, juicy fruit, cherries dipped in chocolate. A cleansing acidity plays against a supple tannin structure, drawing the wine into a moreish, fruity finish.

KANONKOP KADETTE CAPE 220 BLEND

2020 - The bright ruby colour of the Kadette Cape Blend 2019 has vibrant crimson hues, with complimenting aromas of raspberries, dark cherries, plums, cinnamon and cloves. Supple, elegant tannins and a fresh seam of acidity are beautifully balanced with a vibrant explosion of fruit on the palate. Juicy flavours of red and black fruits, and a hint of chocolate, dominate the lengthy finish.

2020 - This Bordeaux styled blend Cabernet Sauvignon (66%), Merlot (28%) and Cabernet Franc (6%) grapes were hand selected from various sites, including the warmer Polkadraai area, and the cooler Helderberg Basinse Bay. We also look at soils, that vary from Malmesbury-schale, decomposed granite to Clovelly. We aim to do things as natural as possible, which is why we do both alcoholic- and malolactic fermentation all naturally.

2020 - Mulderbosch Faithful Hound celebrates the virtues of Bordeaux's great tradition of blending. Aside from investing considerable effort in our own vineyards in close proximity to False Bay, our quest to find the perfect sites for each of the five varieties used in the blend led us from cooler sites to the rich, shale soils of Bottellary. The goal with each bottling of Faithful Hound is to produce a rich, complex wine that comfortably expresses old world class and the generosity of fruit associated with Stellenbosch.

2015 - During our annual vintage review individual barrels are identified and earmarked for the Rabelais blend. 2021 - 60% Syrah | 30% Mourvèdre | 10% Grenache. Bold black fruit and spice are followed by red cherry and raspberry. Notes of rhubarb combine with black pepper and cumin. Tangy acidity balances fine, supple tannins and juicy fruit. Cherries, cinnamon and smoky meat create layers in this refreshing, medium-bodied wine.

2019 - A magical blend of 61% Merlot, 27% Shiraz and 12% Cabernet Sauvignon. A deep red colored wine with an abundance of fruit and hints of vanilla and chocolate on the nose. Smoky and spicy aromas. Named after Kosie & Helène Steenkamps two daughters.

VILLIERA - THE CLAN

2016 - Intensely perfumed with dark berry fruit, liquorice, violets and underlying tobacco, spice and graphite. It is full bodied with ripe succulent tannins and great length. The wine is complemented by a small percentage of Carignan, which freshens the wine, improving drinkability while creating a point of difference.

STELLENBOSCH RESERVE - VAN DER STEL

2021 - 70% Cabernet Sauvignon | 15% Merlot | 6% Cabernet Franc | 6% Petit Verdot | 3% Malbec. Deep, bright ruby in colour, this wine shows expressive cassis and black cherries with Christmas cake spice, thyme, and mocha adding richness. Full-bodied with intense plum and black cherry notes well integrated with spicy notes of clove and cedar. Grippy yet refined tannins compliment the bright, fresh acidity culminating in a dry, dark chocolate finish.

DONKIESBAAI SUIDERKRUIS

2019 - 49% Cinsault, 46% Grenache Noir and 5% Syrah. Expressive cranberry, watermelon and notes of blueberry and cinnamon are very inviting on the nose. The juicy, sweet fruits are balanced beautifully on the palate by delicate tannins and savoury notes of earthiness and new leather. The finish shows juicy flavours of cranberry and redcurrant, and has very good length.

Optimum drinking time will be 5-8 years after the vintage, but the wine should age well for 10-15 years.

2019 - A classic Simonsberg Cabernet, exuding a sense of coolness, despite the warm vintage conditions. A perfumed nose filled with notes of blackcurrants, fennel, cigar box, tea leaf and "fynbos" shrub. The palate is delicate and fresh, with an austere old-world charm about it. Grainy tannins compliment the earthy profile, with subtle hints of liquorice on the lengthy finish.

STELLENBOSCH RESERVE - OU HOOFGEBOU CABERNET SAUVIGNON 360

2022 - Deep, opaque ruby. Rich notes of cassis, blackberry and bramble, combined with pencil shavings and tobacco. A classic Cabernet, showing fine, coating tannin with balanced acidity to support intense black fruit flavours. Dark chocolate and cedar are accompanied by a savoury tomato puree character that adds complexity. Polished, with well integrated oak, resulting in classically styled Cabernet.

MURATIE - MARTIN MELCK 460

2019 - Anna Catherina's second name means 'purity', a virtue Melck valued, and one that this Simonsberg Stellenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon seeks to express with its concentrated dark fruit (black cherries, berries and plums) underscored by fresh acidity and framed by cedar wood and spice from 20 months in French oak (10% new). Sourced from three different blocks on the estate, it's opulent yet polished, a wine of Integration, balance and great length, true to its terroir just as Melck stayed true to his beliefs.

2018 - Classic Cabernet fruit aromas of blackcurrant and cassis are complemented by a hint of violet. Lead pencil shavings and cedar aromas add to the overall complexity and sophistication. On entry the palate is rich, velvety and voluptuous yet remarkably fresh showcasing dark fruit, cherry and dark chocolate. The firm, appetising acidity is balanced by round, structured and juicy tannins. A lingering finish reveals the power to improve with time.

STELLENBOSCH RESERVE - 360 STADSAAL CINSAULT

Intense red fruit flavours follow through on the palate, maraschino cherry, boiled sweets, vanilla and a savoury note of cedar spice. Tangy acidity and firm spicy tannins that make this a very expressive Cinsault with a long, fruity finish.

ROCK OF EYE CINSAULT 400

2022 - The colour is bright vibrant red. The nose is expressive with a complex spicy top note reminiscent of ground black pepper and sandalwood and fruits of fresh red cherry and ripe mulberry. There is an opulent fudge-like aroma that plays with the fresh red fruit aromas and adds a perception of richness to the wine. The elegant palate shows the pepper spice with the mulberry and cherry fruits and finishes dry with a touch of juiciness. As the maiden vintage, this wine is showing tight, dry tannin at this youthful stage and I am curious to see how the wine evolves with maturation.

OTHER RED VARIETALS

DONKIESBAAI GRENACHE 380 NOIR

2020 - A lively combination of red cherries and black currant jump out of the glass. A floral aroma of lavender overlays notes of flint and iron. The fruit profile develops into blueberries on the palate with sour red cherry notes adding to the tangy acidity. Cedar spice lends some savoury complexity to this medium bodied wine, with light yet firm tannins. Vibrant and fresh, with a long sour cherry finish.

THELEMA - VIN DE HEL MUSCAT 45 per glass

2020 - A golden dessert wine with very typical Muscat characters on the nose. The wine shows upfront aromas of pineapple, citrus, apricots, a touch of honey and subtle floral notes. The palate is lush with the perfect balance between sweetness and fresh acidity.
