CAPE OF GOOD HOPE - CAROLINE

2019 - Marsanne (37%), Roussanne (37%), Chenin Blanc (20%), Viognier (6%) - Crunchy dried autumn leaves, vanilla biscuit and roasted stone fruit fragrance. Those nectarine, peach and apricot notes translate to the palate – rich, ripe and fleshy although it remains and elegant, dry and refined mouthful. Acidity counterbalances that ripeness and warmth and there's a pleasant chalky grip too. Complex, structured with delightful mouthfeel and texture. Beautiful integration of oak makes for a long, layered but sophisticated wine.

2020 - Chenin Blanc (45 %) with smaller amounts of Sauvignon Blanc (32 %), Verdehlo (19%), and Viognier (4%) For all its freshness, elegance and focus, the wine's flavours are complex and intense, ranging from bright lemon, fresh pineapple, apricots and juicy nectarine to more concentrated lime marmalade as well as caramel and cream (from barrel fermentation and 11 months of saturation in mostly older French oak). On the palate the initial impression is floral (heady honeysuckle) finishing with white peaches and apricots, with hints of citrus and a fresh acidity - great persistence promising enjoyment over at least five years.

JOURNEY'S END - THE WEATHER STATION

2021 - This Sauvignon Blanc was named The Weather Station, because the SB11 clone, which is one of the core components used in this wine, had a big resurgence in the 1970s in Stellenbosch; it's apt Afrikaans name is 'Weerstasie Kloon' (Weather station clone). Its name derived from its location next to an old Weather Station, which is now the Stellenbosch Wine Campus! Has the pale straw colour of youth, with a tinge of green. A complex wine, there's melon and grapefruit on a bed of apple and Bosche pear, with a seam of freshness giving vitality and extending the flavours.

The 2022 vintage also shows prominent primary aromas of guava. A small addition of Semillon adds to the overall roundness on the palate.

STELLENBOSCH RESERVE - KWEEKSKOOL MERLOT 280

2020 - Aromas of bramble and damson plum combine with dark chocolate, cherry molasses and tobacco. The ripe aromas on the nose follow through onto the palate, with sweet, ripe fruit balanced by savoury notes of bay leaf and thyme. Fine, ripe tannins and fresh acidity support the plush midpalate, culminating in a clean, fruity finish.

Cedar spice lends some savoury complexity to this medium bodied wine, with light yet firm tannins. Vibrant and fresh, with a long sour cherry finish.

2019 - Grenache Noir. This cuvée is made 100 % from Grenache Noir, a Mediterranean grape variety from old vines, and truly represents the expression of « New World » winegrowers on one of the most beautiful terroirs in France.

RUST EN VREDE ESTATE 650

2018 - Named to reflect the planting on the property, the grapes for this wine come from 22 hectares of Cabernet Sauvignon, 7 hectares of Syrah and 1 hectare of Merlo. Rich cassis and mulberry with cedar and tobacco reveal Cabernet as the backbone to the blend, after which fresh red and black cherry with black pepper spice show the Syrah component. Intense fruit flavours are layered with mocha, Christmas cake, sandalwood and leather, bringing complexity to the wine. Fresh, fruity acidity balances the firm, coating tannins, culminating in a clean, dry finish that indicates good ageing potential.

BEYERSKLOOF FIELD BLEND 370

2017 - Remarkable & consistent Bordeaux red, co-grown, fermented and matured 24 months. Cab (80%) and merlot in harmony, showing dark flavours of blackcurrant and spiced berry compote, hint of tealeaf and persistent graphite/mineral finish. Ups the new-oak portion to 100%.

2016 - Intensely perfumed with dark berry fruit, liquorice, violets and underlying tobacco, spice and graphite. It is full bodied with ripe succulent tannins and great length. The wine is complemented by a small percentage of Carignan, which freshens the wine, improving drinkability while creating a point of difference.

THELEMA RABELAIS 700

2015 - During our annual vintage review individual barrels are identified and earmarked for the Rabelais blend. Concentrated aromas of dark berries and cedar wood on the nose are complemented by lovely sweet fruit and polished tannins on the palate. The wine finishes long and firm and will reward cellaring.

SIMONSIG - MERINDOL SYRAH 1300

2017 - The wine has an inky purple hue with a vivid red rim. A complex array of aromas lures you into the glass with ripe raspberries and blackcurrant cordial. Cedar spice gives way to tilled earth and liquorice leading the way out. This powerful wine is well balanced with velvety tannins and juicy fruit concentration in the core. Delicious with Karoo lamb shank, grilled pepper steak or aubergine and porcini mushroom "meatballs" in a tomato-based sauce.

2015 - Lady May is Glenelly's flagship estate wine. The 2015 Bordeaux blend pays tribute to the pedigree of its legendary owner, May de Lencquesaing. Balanced, refined and mineral. etched with underlining fruit power. It is fresh, stylish and subtle with dense and age worthy tannins and a long, tight finish.

CAPE OF GOOD HOPE - PAREL VALLEI MERLOT 390

2015 - Spicy melange of black and blue fruits on a bright, lively appealing nose. Hint of dark chocolate too. Abundant appeal to the bright palate which is packed with toned cherry, blueberry and black hedgerow fruits, supported by a deeper cocoa note. Layered and complex with well integrated oak, the wine is lithe and supple rather than chunky. Subtle oak spice underpins and cradles the fruit and adds length to the aftertaste. Lovely elegance overall.

KANONKOP CABERNET SAUVIGNON 500

2017 - A classic Simonsberg Cabernet, exuding a sense of coolness, despite the warm vintage conditions. A perfumed nose filled with notes of blackcurrants, fennel, cigar box, tea leaf and "fynbos" shrub. The palate is delicate and fresh, with an austere old-world charm about it. Grainy tannins compliment the earthy profile, with subtle hints of liquorice on the lengthy finish.

2019 - Cinnamon, prune and caramelised nuts, dark juicy plum and blackberry pastille; lashings of dark fruit are driven and deep, a plum pudding sweetness lifted with liquorice and seasoned with exotic spice, like grains of paradise, a gingery tone that follows on the finish.

DONKIESBAAI HOOIWYN

45 per glass

2021 - 100% Chenin Blanc, naturally dried grapes. Pale gold in colour with intense aromas of orange blossoms, apricots, litchi and candied orange peel. A luscious wine with good acidity that lifts the palate and gives definition to complex flavours of orange marmalade, beeswax, quince and preserved cumquats, culminating in a clean, honeyed finish.

THELEMA - VIN DE HEL MUSCAT

45 per glass

2020 - A golden dessert wine with very typical Muscat characters on the nose. The wine shows upfront aromas of pineapple, citrus, apricots, a touch of honey and subtle floral notes. The palate is lush with the perfect balance between sweetness and fresh acidity.
